

## **ABSTRACT**

### **The Determination of Attitude Towards Evidence Based Nursing of Nurses**

**Aim:** This research was conducted to determination of attitude towards evidence based nursing of nurses working in the center of Agri province.

**Material and Method:** The research was carried out as a descriptive research between December 2017 and June 2018. The population consisted of all nurses (276) who were working in the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> level health institutions. The sampling method was not applied, as the population composed of 203 nurses who voluntarily accepted to participate in the study. A questionnaire and Attitude Towards Evidence-Based Nursing Scale were used as data collection tools. The approval of ethics committee and institutional permissions were obtained before conducting the research. Frequency, percentage, one way anova, chi-square analysis, mann whitney u test, t test were utilized to evaluate the data.

**Results:** The attitude towards of nurses to evidence-based nursing were found to be moderate according to Attitude Towards Evidence-Based Nursing Scale and it was found to be low according to subscales of nursing Belief, Intention to Practice, Nursing Related Feelings.

**Conclusion:** According to the results of the study, attitude towards of nurses to evidence-based nursing were found to be moderate and the necessity of educational interventions was revealed for development of attitude.
